INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR GOODS

- The Government of the Republic of Cameroon has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Regional Project for Improving the Performance of the Douala–Ndamena Rail/Road Corridor – PCDN and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the supply of Five Hundred and Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred (512,700) linear metres of Fifty-Four (54) kilogram rail. Procurement under this Contract shall be carried out in accordance with the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, Seventh Edition, September 2025. For this contract, the Borrower shall use the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for payments for which the contract provides for the use of a letter of credit.
- CAMRAIL, Concessionaire of the Cameroon Railways and implementing agency for the railway component, now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders meeting the required qualifications for:
 - Supplying Five Hundred and Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred (512,700) linear metres of Fifty-Four (54) kilogram rail on a CIP Douala, Cameroon basis within a period of 18 months from contract signature;
 - Unloading the rails at the port of Douala destination quay for each partial delivery;
 - Loading the rails onto the Purchaser's wagons at the Port of Douala, on the track alongside the quay, by the Supplier for each partial delivery.
- The qualification requirements, as specified in the Bidding Document and relating, on the one hand, to financial capacity, and on the other hand, to technical capacity and experience, are those set out under Item
- 1 – Qualification – of Section III, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.
- Procurement will be conducted through Open International Competitive Procurement, as defined in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, Seventh Edition, September 2025, and is open to all eligible bidders from eligible countries as defined in said Regulations.
- Bids shall be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the Bidding Document. The following weights shall apply to the rated criteria (including technical and non-price factors): 50%, and to the Bid Price: 50%.

- Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **19 May 2026 at 09:00 GMT (10:00 a.m. local time)**. Electronic submission of bids shall not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. The outer envelopes marked "ORIGINAL BID", and the inner envelopes marked "TECHNICAL PART" shall be publicly opened in the presence of bidders' representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below, on **19 May 2026 at 09:30 GMT (10:30 a.m. local time)**. All envelopes marked "FINANCIAL PART – SECOND ENVELOPE" shall remain unopened and shall be kept in a secure place by the Purchaser until the second public opening.
- All bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration in accordance with the form included in Section IV – Bidding Forms.
- Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the beneficial ownership of the successful bidder as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form included in the Bidding Document.
